Mural Painting!

Beginning Wheel Throwing

Join Nicole in the ceramics studio for a week long intensive and learn the basics of wheel throwing. We will spend a portion of each day using the pottery wheel, and by the end of the week have two wheel thrown pots ready to go into the kiln. We will also learn the importance of wedging and trimming, and have some fun decorating the surface of our pots.
